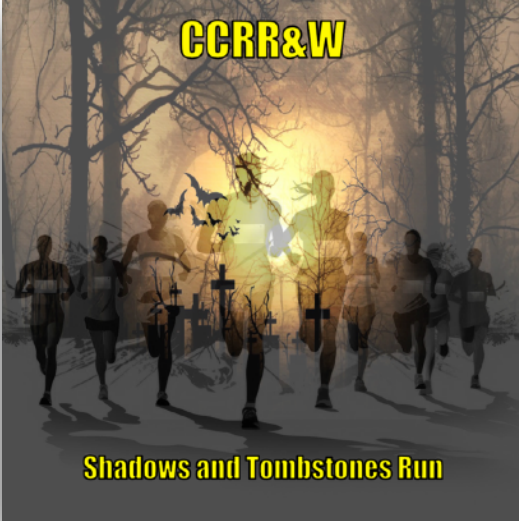




Capital City Road Runners & Walkers 2025 Point Series - Event #10
